



Recyclable skittles

TIN CAN TARGETS

Step 1: Save your recycling. Wash out each can thoroughly.

Step 2: Stack them up and try to knock them down.

OPTIONAL: Decorate your cans!

- Measure your can's height and circumference.
- Mark this out on paper and cut to size.
- Draw your designs or use scrap paper to decorate.
- Wrap around your tin and tape in place.



What you will need

TIN CAN TARGETS
6 or 10 clean, empty tin cans
Paper & pens
Ruler, scissors & tape
Bean bags or balls

PLASTIC BOTTLE BOWLING

Step 1: Make sure your bottles are clean and the labels have been removed.

Step 2: You need to add some weight to the bottles to stop them blowing over in the wind (the heavier they are, the harder they are to knock over). You could use stones, sand or water. Add food colouring to the water to make them different colours.

Step 3: Screw the lids back on tightly and set them up in a triangle.

Step 4: Take turns throwing the ball to knock down as many as you can.

What you will need

PLASTIC BOTTLE BOWLING
10 plastic bottles of similar size
Paper, pens, glue
Food colouring to decorate
Stones & water
Ball
